

Public Review of Land Conservation Plan

The Stewardship Council will distribute its Draft Land Conservation Plan (LCP) Volume I & II for public review and comment beginning June 18!

The LCP provides the framework to conserve open space, natural and cultural resources, agricultural and timber uses, and public recreation on more than 140,000 acres of watershed lands.

Public participation is critical. Please read this announcement to learn how you can participate in providing comments.

Who should comment on the LCP?

The Stewardship Council would like anyone with an interest in the future ownership and management of the watershed lands to provide written comments

When will the LCP be available for review?

The Draft LCP Volumes I & II will be available for public review from June 18 to August 21, 2007. The public review period is designed to allow adequate time for all interested parties to review and provide written comment on the documents.

Where will the LCP be available for review?

1. A CD-ROM containing the LCP will be mailed to all stakeholders in the Stewardship Council's database.
2. The LCP will be available to review and comment online at <http://lcp.stewardshipcouncil.org>
3. The LCP will be available in hard-copy at select public buildings within the 22 affected counties.

How can comments on the LCP be submitted?

1. All interested parties included in the Stewardship Council database will receive the LCP on a CD-ROM. The CD-ROM will include an electronic comment form that can be submitted to the Stewardship Council via email. More About the Stewardship Council

The Stewardship Council is a private foundation established in 2004 as part of a Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) settlement agreement. Our staff and board include experts in conservation, natural resource management, business, and public policy. The Stewardship Council has prepared the Land Conservation Plan (LCP) to guide the permanent conservation of over 140,000 acres of Watershed Lands in California currently owned and managed by PG&E.

About the LCP

The LCP provides the framework for the enhancement of the existing environmental and economic benefits of the watershed lands on an overall basis. Central to this framework is the preservation and enhancement of a broad range of beneficial public values, including habitat, open space, outdoor recreation, sustainable forestry, agricultural uses, and historic and cultural values.



The LCP contains three-volumes.

Volume I: The Land Conservation Framework includes legal requirements, background on the planning process, and discussion of relevant regulatory processes.

Volume II: Planning Unit Concepts presents management objectives & potential measures to preserve and/or enhance the beneficial public values within each planning unit.

Volume III: Disposition Packages will be developed between 2008 and 2013 as a series of documents. It will detail the specific land conservation and/or disposition requirements for each parcel or parcel cluster within each of the 47 Planning Units.
