



**STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL BOARD OF DIRECTORS
TO MEET IN OAKLAND ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2011**

PUBLIC ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND AND PROVIDE INPUT

San Mateo, Calif., September 7, 2011 – The Pacific Forest and Watershed Lands Stewardship Council, a land conservation and youth investment foundation, announces its next board of directors meeting will be held in Oakland on Thursday, September 15, 2011. The Stewardship Council Board of Directors may take action on the following agenda items related to its Land Conservation Program, as well as other matters involving the Stewardship Council Youth Investment Program:

Fee Title Holder Recommendations

The board may consider taking action on recommendations from the Watershed Planning Committee for fee title holders on select PG&E watershed lands as follows:

- California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) to become the prospective recipient of fee title to approximately 2,251 acres available for donation within eight parcels (Parcels 292-299) in the Cow Creek planning unit, and PG&E to retain fee title to approximately 15 acres available for donation within Parcel 293.
- Placer County to receive fee title to approximately 15 acres within one parcel (Parcel 871) in the Lower Drum planning unit

Conservation Easement Holder Recommendations

The board may consider taking action on recommendations from the Watershed Planning Committee for conservation easement holders on select PG&E watershed lands as follows:

- The Shasta Land Trust as the prospective organization to hold a conservation easement over the lands in the Cow Creek planning unit
- The Placer Land Trust as the prospective organization to hold conservation easements over the lands in the Lower Drum planning unit and the lands in the Fordyce Lake planning unit that are located in Placer County
- The Nevada County Land Trust as the prospective organization to hold conservation easements over the lands in the Fordyce Lake planning unit that are located in Nevada County
- The Mother Lode Land Trust as the prospective organization to hold conservation easements over the lands in the Middle Fork Stanislaus River planning unit
- The Northern California Regional Land Trust as the prospective organization to hold conservation easements over lands in the Oroville planning unit and the lands in the Philbrook Reservoir planning unit
